If it's your first time checking out, not a problem! Just fill out an information slip (found in the desk caddy) and paperclip it to your book card.



And for the elementary age kids are books in the Childhood of Famous Americans series on some great Presidents and other great Americans who have made a major contribution to our country.







# Music CDs




